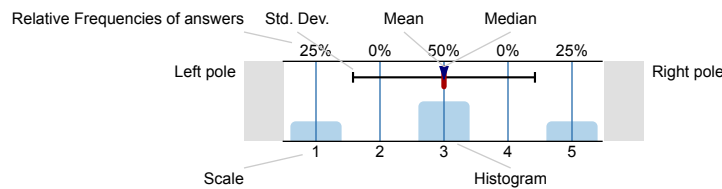

1.1) The instructor communicated clearly the expectations for the course.



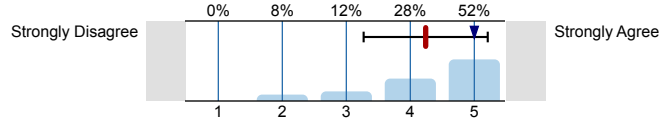

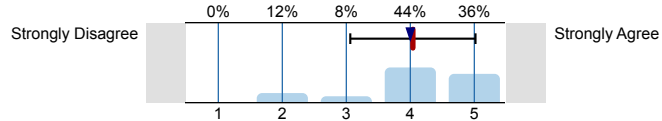

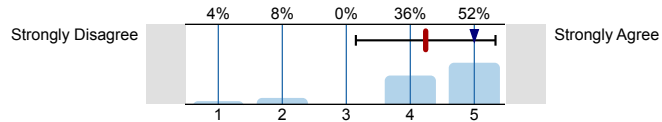

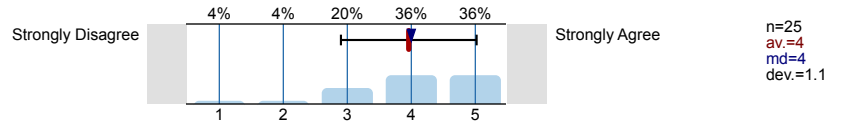

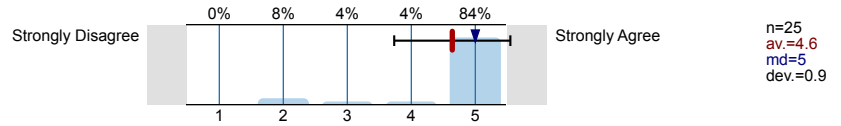

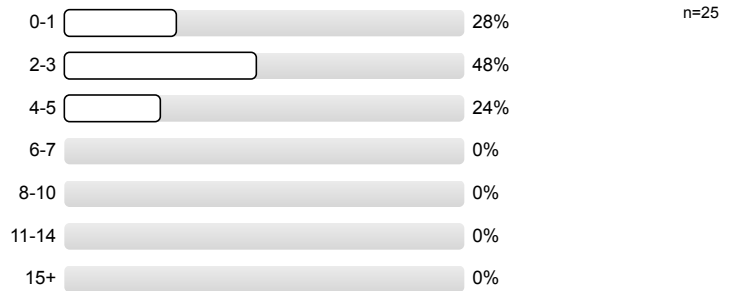
